VOLUNTEER ROLE:

Drop In Volunteer (TUESDAYS)

We are open to Volunteers from a wide range of backgrounds; however they must be over 21.

PURPOSE OF THE ROLE:

To assist in the provision of a range of health & wellbeing services for young people aged 16-21; Through The Junction Drop In.

MAIN TASKS:

Assisting with setting up the Drop In

- Taking part in planning Drop In activities and the setting up of rooms

Assisting During the Drop In

- Welcoming young people and ensuring they feel included
- Getting young people to sign in & helping them identify reason(s) for visit
- Selecting activities and information to engage the young people in discussion about a range of health issues
- Supporting staff in managing the behaviour and conduct of young people

Assisting with the end of Drop In procedures

- Tidying up Drop In, securing doors & shutters, checking surrounding area for litter
- Participate in Drop In recordings and associated paperwork

REQUIRED SKILLS, QUALITIES & EXPERIENCE:

- Reliability, Flexibility and Resourcefulness
- Energy, Enthusiasm and Good communication skills
- Confidence to initiate conversation & discussion with young people
- Knowledge of issues affecting young people
- Ability to work in a sometimes fast paced and changing environment
- Ability to engage with disparate groups of young people
- Experience of group and one-to-one work (*an advantage*)

TRAINING & SUPPORT PROVIDED:

- Induction with Volunteer Organiser
- Drop In procedure induction with Project Worker
- Briefed by staff team prior to each Volunteer session
- Named staff member for on site support
- Support & supervision meetings with Volunteer Organiser
- Good practice meetings, with other volunteers
- Other training as identified/negotiated.

ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to adhere to The Junction policies and to demonstrate an understanding of the confidentiality policy in particular
